like a face mask? As it turns out, the sheet variety might give you a boost in pimple-fighting power while calming inflammation and potentially helping fade acne scars.

Our best overall pick is Mediheal Tea Tree Essential Blemish Control Sheet Mask, which uses a combination of salicylic acid to unclog pores, tea tree to prevent new breakout, and chamomile to calm inflamed skin. For a more affordable pick, consider Yes To Tomatoes Acne Fighting Paper Mask, which also contains salicylic acid as well as fruit enzymes to encourage cell turnover and purge pores.

According to Picky medical advisor Claudia Christin, MBBS, PhD, masks aren't always as effective as leave-on products simply because they're on your skin for a short period. "However," she says, "there are some ingredients you can look for that may help fade acne scars" and keep breakouts at bay.

"A face mask with exfoliating ingredients may help remove the pigmented skin cells to reveal brighter, [more] even-toned skin," Christin tells Byrdie. She recommends alpha-, beta-, and poly-hydroxy acids (AHA, BHA, and PHA, respectively).

We conducted hours of research on the best sheet masks for acne. We tried some of the top-rated masks out there, our testers taking note of how effectively they cleared pimples, unclogged pores, and the effect they had on skin texture. We also considered a range of skin types and concerns from sensitive to oily, and everything in between. Our team then combined these results with our own research of fan-favorites, plus skin expert picks to

What to Look for in a Sheet Mask for Acne

Acne-fighting ingredients

In order to treat acne, you need acne-fighting ingredients. Opt to choose formulas that are made with ingredients that help eliminate and treat acne. AHAs (salicylic acid, glycolic acid, etc.)^[9] and green tea are just some of the ingredients that will help rid your skin of pesky breakouts. These ingredients may also help with other skin conditions, like hyperpigmentation.^[10]

Comfortable Wear

A mask that wears comfortably can enhance the self care experience. Look for masks that appear to be cut to the size of your face or are designed to adhere to its contours.

Formula

Because there are so many different sheet masks out there, make sure you choose the ones that are designed to treat acne. They'll typically contain acne-fighting ingredients and work to treat and prevent breakouts. Try to also find a formula that claims to clarify or purify and helps reduce excess sebum production, which can cause more oil (and breakouts). [11]



Sheet masks allow the serum to be distributed more evenly and absorbed directly into the skin. This lets the acne-fighting ingredients (or whatever ingredients treat your skin condition) to go to bat in treating those pesky breakouts.

Can I reuse a sheet mask?

No, you should not reuse a sheet mask. When you place the sheet mask on your face, it's likely that it will absorb dirt and bacteria. While taking the excess serum from the package is totally fine, you shouldn't reuse the actual mask, as it can potentially reintroduce bacteria and dirt onto your skin.

Should sheet masks be refrigerated?

They don't have to be stored in the fridge, but it won't hurt. When you put them on after refrigerating, the cool temperatures may give you an added cooling effect, which can potentially reduce some puffiness.
