12 Best Sunscreen Sticks for All-Day Protection (Tested and Reviewed in 2024)

If there's one thing you need to know in this world, it's that <u>sunscreen</u> is the most important part of your <u>skincare routine</u> (ya know, if you want to prevent skin cancer and fine lines—AKA everyone on Earth). But reapplying midday is a frickin hassle, especially if you're out and about. My secret weapon? Sunscreen sticks: An efficient, compact, and portable option that makes sun protection so damn easy. Just glide the stick across your face, and boom, you're protected.

But is it as effective as slathering on your go-to facial sunscreen? Eh, it depends. Ahead, I chatted with top dermatologists and skincare experts about how sunscreen sticks work, their benefits and disadvantages, and how to choose the best one for you. I also shared my 12 favorites below, so no matter your budget, preference for mineral or chemical formulas, or desired finish, there's one that you're sure to love.

If you're someone who spends a lot of time outside breaking a sweat or even swimming, this water-resistant option is our top pick. With an SPF of 50, you're protected no matter your activity level. Aesthetician Elizabeth Hand also praises this sunscreen stick for containing 13 percent zinc oxide, leaving zero white cast behind. "Super smooth and easy to use, this formula doesn't feel greasy whatsoever," she says. "This stick is great for all skin tones seeking maximum coverage with a sheer application."

My vibe is wet, glossy, glowy skin à la <u>Hailey Bieber</u>, which is why I stan this sunscreen stick from Kopari. It mimics a <u>highlighter</u> stick, thanks to the shimmery sheen it leaves on my skin without making my face greasy. It goes on completely clear otherwise, though, so it's ideal for all skin tones. Plus, it's loaded with aloe vera, so it hydrates and soothes my skin a lil bit, mitigating some of the redness I'm prone to. But it also contains some coconut oil to help add a dewy look to my skin, as well as majorly moisturize when my skin gets dry.

This affordable, mineral sunscreen stick is not only one of my favorites, but loved by aesthetic nurse practitioner <u>Jodi Logerfo</u>, too. "I like this because it is made with zinc, so it's mineral-based," she says. "It provides broad-spectrum protection—UVA and UVB—and spreads easily on the skin in my experience," says Dr. Logerfo, adding that it's also quite moisturizing. FYI: Mineral sunscreens often get a bad rep due to the white cast they leave behind (a result of the zinc oxide in the formula), and this one does go on white. But not to worry—it's nothing a little rubbing in won't fix.

Now that I've experienced the magic and ease that is a sunscreen stick, I honestly often prefer it to my other go-to liquid sunscreens. But they're not all super great under foundation and concealer—except Supergoop's Glow Stick. It gives my skin a radiant, glowy finish before blending creams and powders on top. Hand loves it too: "The glow it leaves is really unmatched," she says. "It's perfect for dry to normal skin types, but even oily skin types who want to be mistaken for a glazed Krispy Kreme might love it too," she adds.

Sticks can sometimes translate to sticky, but not this one from Coola. It glides on easily and also works to moisturize your skin, thanks to niacinamide and <u>hyaluronic</u> acid, some of the best skincare ingredients for hydration.

Cosmo's beauty editor <u>Beth Gillette</u> swears by this for reapplying her sunscreen in the summer: "When I'm at the beach, or on a boat—you know, just ~summer things~— the last thing I wanna do is cover my face with a goopy sunscreen," she says. "But this Coola stick feels so lightweight while still being super hydrating, making me look dewy but not greasy at all."

Live Tinted is all about making products for tan to deep skin tones, so trust when I say this sunscreen stick goes on completely clear—no white cast in sight. I can swipe it on a few times throughout the day, and I never notice that it starts to pill or get sticky either. Instead, the stick just hydrates my skin, leaving behind a dewy finish that works with your makeup rather than against it. For those who spend a lot of time outside or sweat easily, it's also water and sweat-resistant for up to 80 minutes, so you don't have to worry.

I'm a huge fan of MDSolarSciences tinted sunscreens, so when I found this stick formula, I was v intrigued. Now, it's become one of my go-tos when I want a tiny bit of extra coverage with my sunscreen stick. It has a very lightweight tint that helps counteract any potential white cast (since it's a mineral, zinc-based formula), all the while ever-so-slightly evening out my skin tone and reducing a lil redness.



"It has a clean, all-mineral formula, non-greasy texture, and can be used everywhere," she says. It's also TSA-friendly, so you can get through security without worrying about having to throw it away and getting burned on your beach trip.

Another Dr. Marmur approved pick, this stick goes on smoothly and is "water-resistant, with a clean formulation infused with hyaluronic acid and three essential ceramides." TBH, it's actually formulated with kids in mind, so it's excellent for very sensitive, delicate skin, people with dermatitis, or even for those with rosacea. And because it's safe, don't forget to apply it to your lips, nose, earlobes, and around the eyes.
