Comfortable devices you can use on wet *or* dry skin

The best electric razors for women aren't just less painful than [wax strips](#) and lower-maintenance than disposable razors—they're gentler on your skin too. "They often shave slightly above the skin surface, which reduces the risk of hairs curling back into the skin and causing ingrown hairs," says [Hope Mitchell, MD](#), a board-certified dermatologist at [Mitchell Dermatology](#). Most can be used wet or dry (with or without shaving cream), so you can squeeze in a quick touch-up whenever you need it. To find the right one for you, *Glamour* editors tested more than a dozen top-rated models. Below, find our six standout electric shavers for [bikini lines](#), legs, sensitive skin, facial hair, and more.

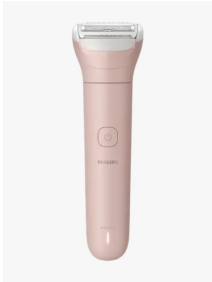

The best electric razor we've tried, this tool effortlessly targets hard-to-reach areas: The included skin-stretcher cap gently tightens the skin and lifts hairs upright, helping the shaver work more effectively and evenly, especially in harder-to-shave areas. Our testers praised the **close shave** they achieved on their legs and bikini lines, thanks to its responsive, slightly rounded head, which glides smoothly over curves and helps prevent irritation by evenly distributing pressure and reducing tugging. At under \$60 (or cheaper if you opt for the [model with four accessories](#) instead of seven), it's worth the investment because it's irritant-free, does a great job of cutting hair **without leaving skin red or irritated afterward**, and gives you a close shave without your skin feeling burned or stripped.

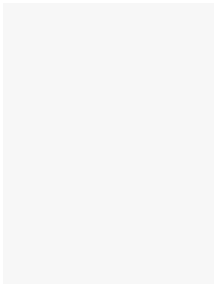

The Meridian pick isn't a traditional razor—it's technically a bikini trimmer—but it earns a spot here for being one of the **safest ways to groom sensitive areas** on your body like your underarms, beard, groin, and bikini line without irritation or nicks. Its ceramic blades resist rust and stay sharper longer than steel, delivering an even trim that **gets impressively close** while staying gentle on skin. The waterproof design works in or out of the shower, and a built-in travel lock keeps it from turning on in your bag. Our editors have had their Meridian electric trimmers for about two years now and report that they work just as well as they did straight out of the box, making it the most durable of the bunch.

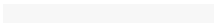

If your main goal is smooth legs with little fuss, this electric shaver gets the job done quickly. The floating four-blade head **hugs the contours of your legs** to cover more ground with each pass, while the **ergonomic, nonslip handle** makes it easy to maneuver around tricky spots like the knees and ankles. It's **fully waterproof** for wet or dry shaving and comes with a trimmer guard for maintaining hair length, but we'd reach for a smaller tool when tackling more precise areas like the bikini line.

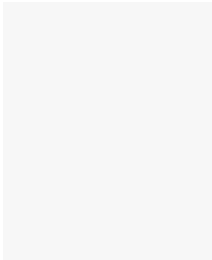

The **compact head on this wet-and-dry trimmer** makes it especially easy to maneuver around the bikini line, reaching tighter areas without feeling bulky or awkward. Its **tiny stainless-steel blades trim hair closely** while staying gentle on delicate skin like the bikini line, helping minimize razor bumps and post-shave irritation. During testing, we found that one to two passes were enough for a clean trim, with an extra pass delivering an even smoother finish. It comes with four attachments for trimming and grooming, runs on one battery (no charging dock required), and is lightweight enough to toss in a toiletry bag for travel.

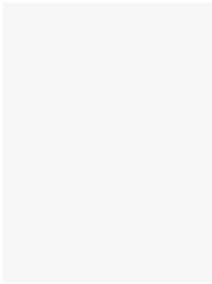

If you’re someone who prefers a short, sweet shower routine, this **ergonomic pick** is completely waterproof and can be used in the shower for a swift, effective trim. It has a soft matte silicone finish that lets you easily grip the handle and buzz hair on your legs or bikini line in minutes. The **ceramic blades are very gentle on skin** and won’t leave you irritated, red, or bumpy. It has a protective titanium guard, too, to prevent you from nicking your skin, especially if you’re short on time and doing touch-ups. The charging dock is not only a sleek addition to your bathroom counter but also ultraconvenient for keeping the groomer charged at all times.

How to choose an electric razor

- ### What's the difference between foil and rotary electric razors?

have round, spinning heads that adjust to the curves of your face or body,” she says, making them easier to maneuver around contours like the underarms, bikini line, and chin. Neither is universally better—it ultimately comes down to where you’re shaving and your personal preference.

What’s the difference between epilators, electric razors, and trimmers?

TL;DR: Electric razors are best for a quick, close shave, [epilators](#) offer the longest-lasting results, and trimmers are ideal for gentle grooming and maintaining length. Here’s more of a breakdown:

- **Electric razors** (also called electric shavers) cut hair at the skin’s surface using foil or rotary blades. They’re quick, easy to use, and generally gentler on the skin than manual razors and are a popular choice for the legs, underarms, and bikini line.
- **Epilators** remove hair from the root using dozens of tiny tweezers. Because they pull hair out rather than cut it, results can last up to four weeks—but the process is typically more uncomfortable. They’re often best suited to larger areas like the legs and arms rather than more sensitive areas.
- **Trimmers** don’t shave hair down to the skin. Instead, they shorten it to an even length using an oscillating blade, often with adjustable guards. They’re the gentlest option of the three and ideal if you want to tidy up the bikini line or maintain a specific hair length rather than remove it completely.

How to use an electric razor

Prep the skin. Start by exfoliating and cleaning the bikini area, which removes dead skin cells, creates a smooth shave, and reduces the risk of irritation and ingrown hair. Trimming or shaving in the shower will be more comfortable than shaving dry, since the force required to cut through hair is lower than when it’s dry, says [Caitlin Orszulak](#), senior scientist at [P&G Grooming](#).

How to shave your legs and body: Foil razors perform well on flatter areas, while rotary razors may feel more comfortable on curves such as knees or underarms. Move in long, steady motions and let the razor glide—avoid pressing down.

How to shave your bikini line: In the intimate region where skin is more sensitive, Dr. Westbay recommends reaching for a foil razor or a bikini trimmer, which are more precise and gentler. Stick to slow, careful passes, and start with a guard or trimming attachment, if your device includes one, to help prevent nicks.

How to shave your face: When shaving, apply light pressure and go against the grain for a closer shave. A foil razor works best here—stick to short, straight strokes and keep the skin taut for better contact.

How do you avoid irritation when using an electric razor?

To help prevent irritation, shave after a warm shower, use light pressure, and let the razor glide over your skin rather than pressing down. “I also recommend shaving in the direction the hair grows, especially if you’re prone to ingrowns,” says Dr. Mitchell. Finish with a fragrance-free moisturizer, and if irritation does occur, stop shaving until your skin calms down. A gentle moisturizer—and, if needed, a short course of over-the-counter 1% hydrocortisone—can help reduce inflammation.

Other razors we tested

- The [Remington Smooth & Silky On-the-Go Shaver](#) is an **under-\$20 pick for travel**—compact, lightweight, and easy to toss in a toiletry bag—and great to have on hand for quick leg and underarm touch-ups, especially if it slips your mind in the shower. The razor is easy to hold, and the two main blades are mounted at different angles, so it works on all sorts of body parts. While we like this one for on-the-go use, we removed it from our list because it didn’t give us a close enough shave compared to the brand’s Smooth and Silky razor.
- The [Finishing Touch Flawless Bikini Shaver and Trimmer](#) is a **budget-friendly**, battery-powered option with a light for precision, but it only works on dry skin. Our tester liked the built-in light but found the angled head awkward—especially for left-handed use—and noted some irritation

afterward. We ultimately had to cut it from the list because the product is sadly no longer available!

- The **Fur Trim System** earned favor for its two-in-one trimmer-and-shaver design and **exceptionally close shave**. However, the shaving head wasn't as flexible around curves as our favorite picks, and because it lacks a protective foil, our tester nicked herself a couple of times. At \$120, it's also quite expensive compared to other women's electric razors on this list.

- The **Schick Hydro Silk TrimStyle Bikini Trimmer** is a smart travel companion, combining an electric bikini trimmer on one end with a manual five-blade razor on the other.

Compact, lightweight, and battery-operated, it's easy to toss into a toiletry bag, and our testers liked that the trimmer made it easy to tidy up before shaving. We ultimately left it off our list because it isn't a true all-electric razor, making it less versatile than our top picks.

- The **Gillette Venus Gentle Electric Trimmer** is suitable for **all hair types** (including coarse), is cordless, and can be used either wet or dry. This razor is one of the easiest to clean, as well, because it has a single line of blades that can be rinsed under water without having to take it apart. We sadly removed it from this list because it's currently unavailable to shop for.

How we tested electric razors

We researched more than 30 top-rated electric razors before selecting 10 models to test based on their features, price, and availability. We also consulted board-certified dermatologists to better understand what shoppers should look for and which features matter most.

Glamour contributors tested each razor at least twice, using it on its intended areas—including the legs, underarms, bikini line, upper lip, and cheeks—before sharing detailed feedback. Every model was evaluated on:

- **Ease of use:** How comfortable it was to hold and maneuver, especially around trickier areas like the knees, ankles, and bikini line.
- **Comfort:** Whether it tugged at hair or caused nicks, irritation, or razor burn.
- **Battery life:** Runtime, charging speed, and overall reliability.
- **Wet/dry performance:** How well it worked in and out of the shower, with and without shaving cream.
- **Maintenance:** How easy it was to clean after each use.
- **Value:** Whether its performance and features justified the price.

Models we didn't include often missed the mark on comfort (some tugged or irritated sensitive skin), battery life (dying before finishing a full shave), or overall value (not offering enough features for the price). The final list reflects the razors that balanced performance, comfort, and reliability—the ones our testers said they'd actually keep using in their own routines.
